Also, every Purchase Order now displays the vendor's minimum order amounts. This helps you build and issue orders in volumes that save you money on shipping and freight. By taking advantage of volume discounts and setting dollar amount thresholds, you'll be sure to decrease your inventory costs.

More Powerful Mobile Warehouse

Fishbowl Mobile Warehouse now includes a Move module that allows you to rearrange the location of inventory items in your warehouse on the go.

Inventory quickly becomes disorganized when location changes are made without updating Fishbowl Inventory. In Fishbowl Mobile Warehouse 2010.3, all location changes can be made on site and are instantly recorded to your database, saving you time and money. Move also works across multiple location groups, making it easy to move items from one warehouse to another.

- Configurable parts can now be added to a PO, RMA or SO credit return.
- A shortage warning has been added to the MO finish wizard.
- Partially picked items are marked in the WO finish wizard.
- A New Production report was created.
- Check version option was added to the Right Click of the Fishbowl Server tray icon.
- When you follow the server link to check updates, you don't have to fill out the download form.

Recommended Steps to Upgrade Fishbowl

1. On the Server computer, close the Fishbowl Client and exit the Fishbowl Server.
2. Make a copy of your database (usually in the data folder in the Fishbowl directory). If you

have images or custom reports you will want to copy those as well.

3. Install the new version of Fishbowl on the Server computer. Run the Fishbowl Server and wait until the database update is complete.
4. Install the new version on all of the Client computers with the "Quick Client" option.
